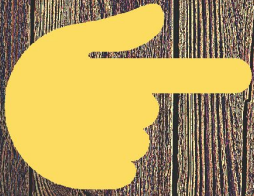

Why are animals intelligent?

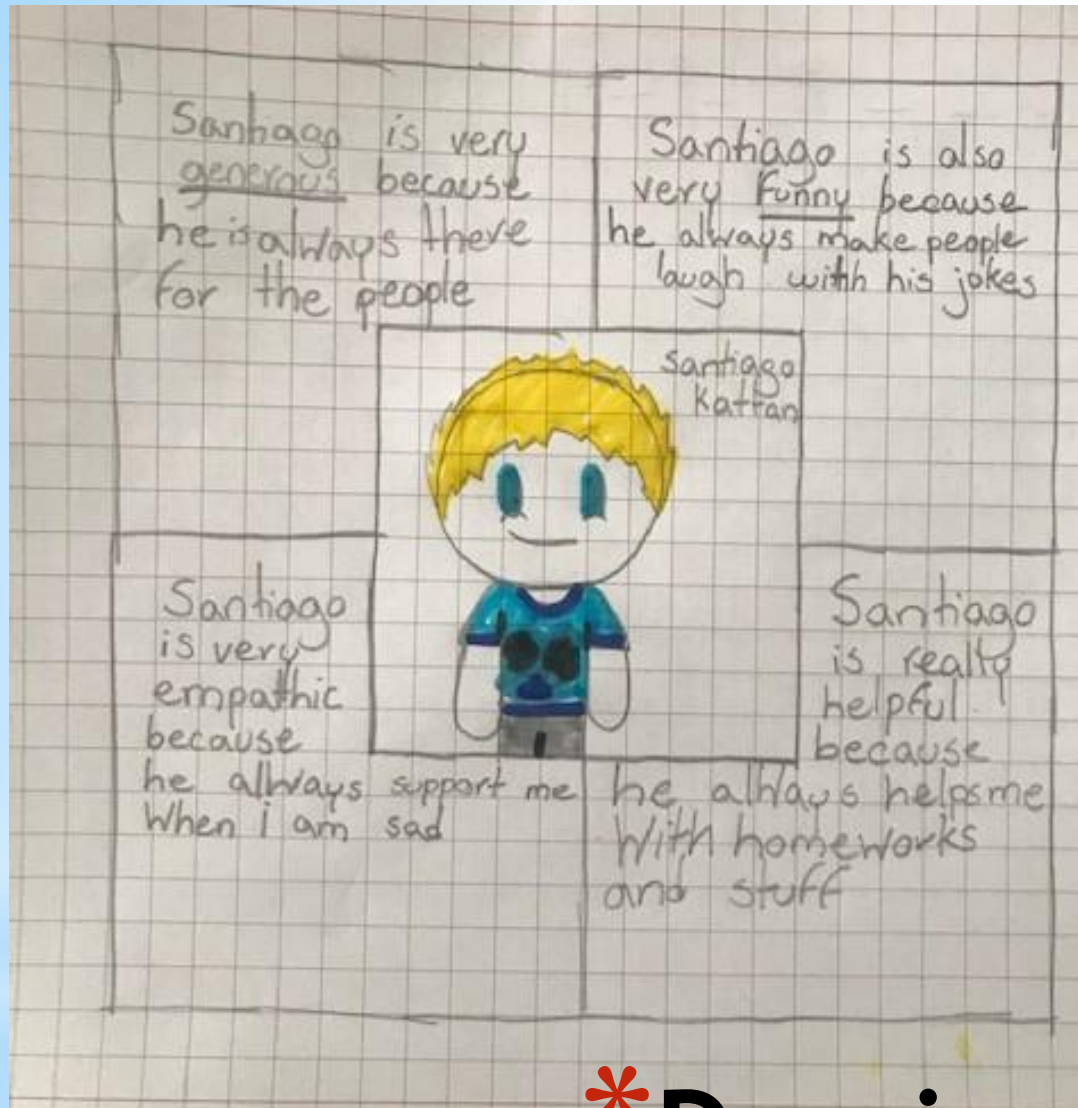
* THE ARMADILLO
